# Tallinn – Medieval, Urban, Digital, Modern

- ❖ Among the least-polluted cities in the world
- ❖ Green areas: 25% of the city territory
- ❖ #4 the most biodiverse city in Europe
- ❖ + 12 km<sup>2</sup> of nature parks
- ❖ 8 Nature reserve & NATURA 2000 areas
- ❖ 22 Protected parks
- ❖ 2 Islands & 1 Bog
- ❖ 18 Lakes (5 natural, 13 artificial)
- ❖ 3 Rivers, 3 Streams
- ❖ Length of coastline: 46 km

# Green Capital 2023 community based activities

- ❖ Activity Days together with locals and visitors
- ❖ World Cleanup Day
- ❖ Citizens Assambly (4th)– 60 people aged 16+, approved 39 proposals, that where handed to the City - "How can we link Tallinn's green spaces into an inviting urban whole?,, - landscape, urban planning, biodivercity, mobility, social care

# Inclusive Budget – vote for best solutions

- ❖ Ca. 10.000 Tallinn residents took part in the vote
- ❖ The total planned amount of the inclusive budget in 2023 is one million euros
  
- ❖ community sauna to lake Haabersti, cozy pop-up parks, building public toilets to parks, childrens parks and outdoor gymnastics parks, water taps around City
  
- ❖ Inclusive budget has become important part to communities to build a better environment



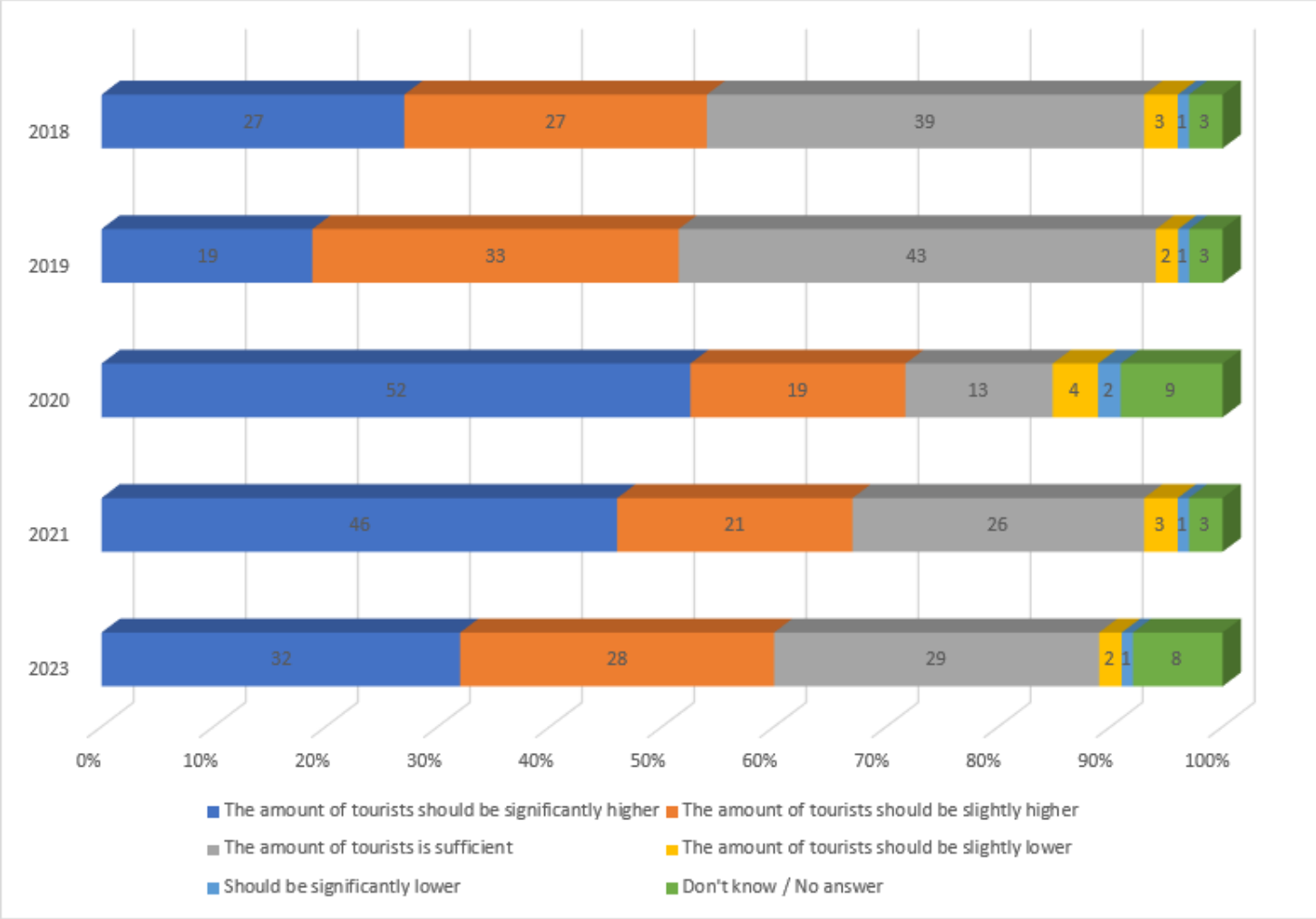
# Tourism in Tallinn – holistic approach to urban space and cohabitat with locals
